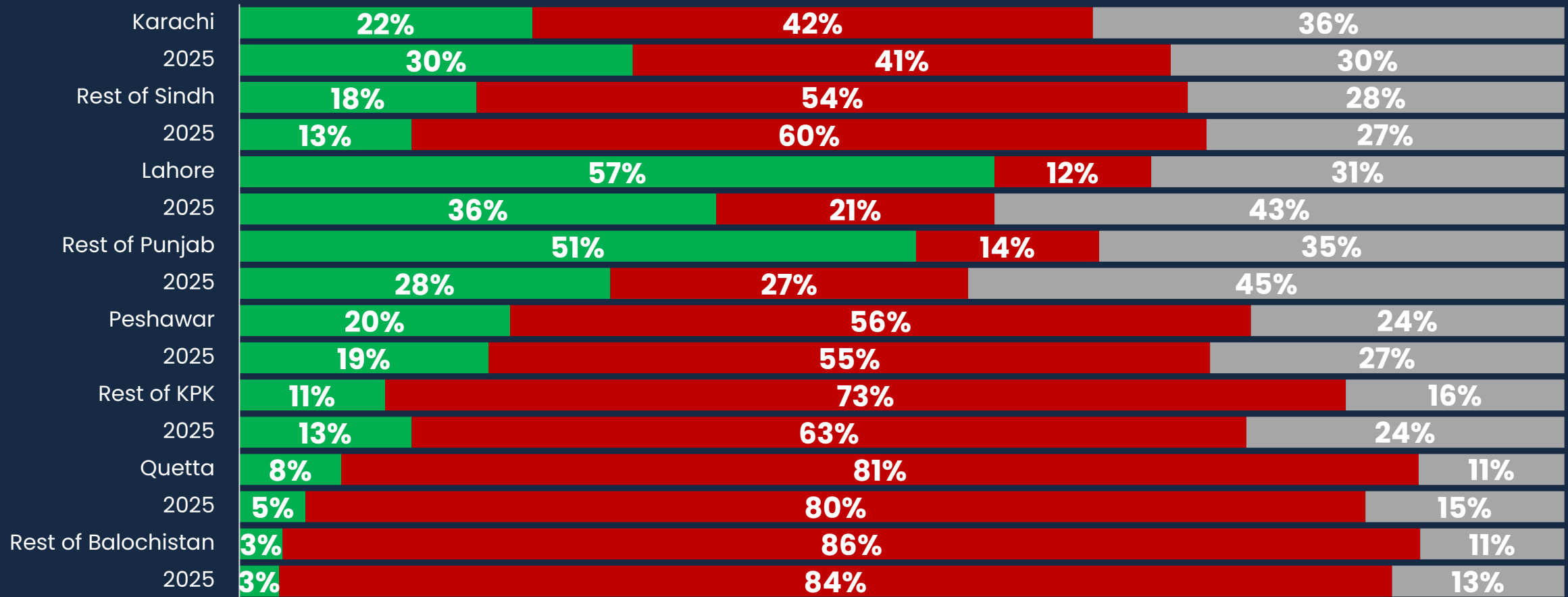

■ Improved ■ Deteriorated ■ No change

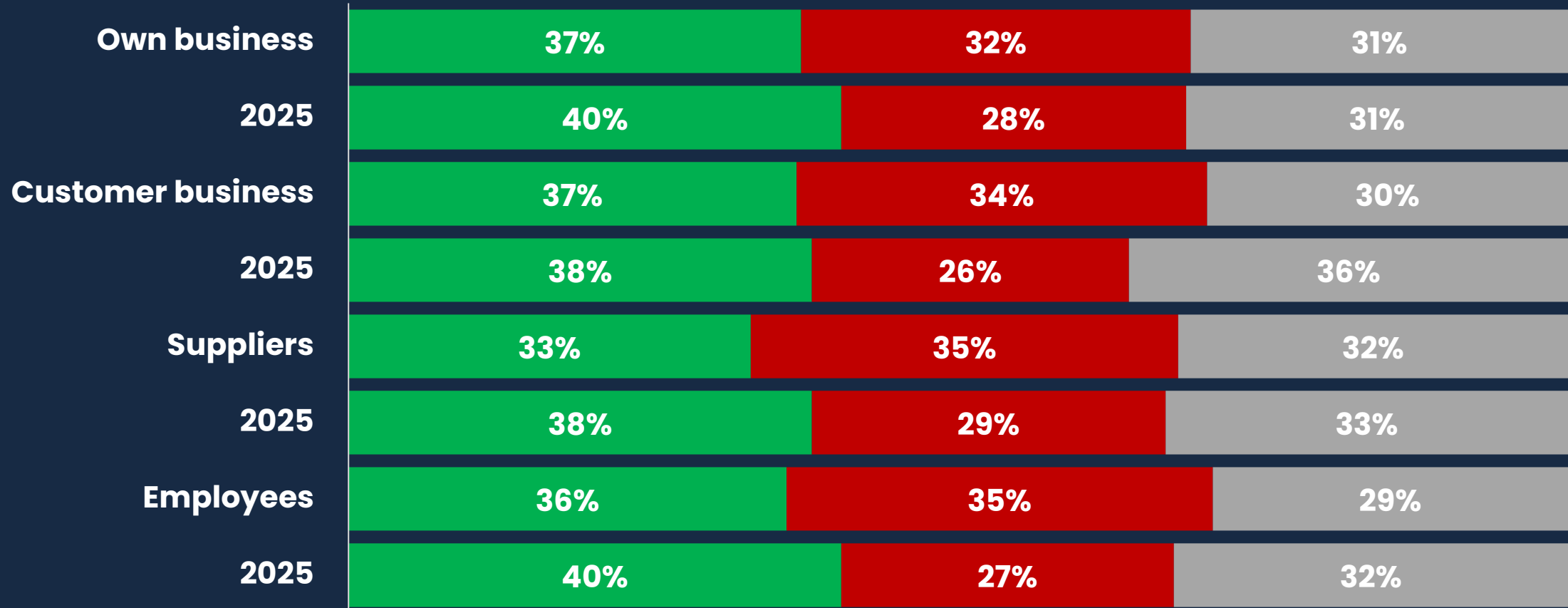


Punjab improved, whereas Karachi and the western regions continue to be key security concerns

■ Improved ■ Detetriorated ■ No change

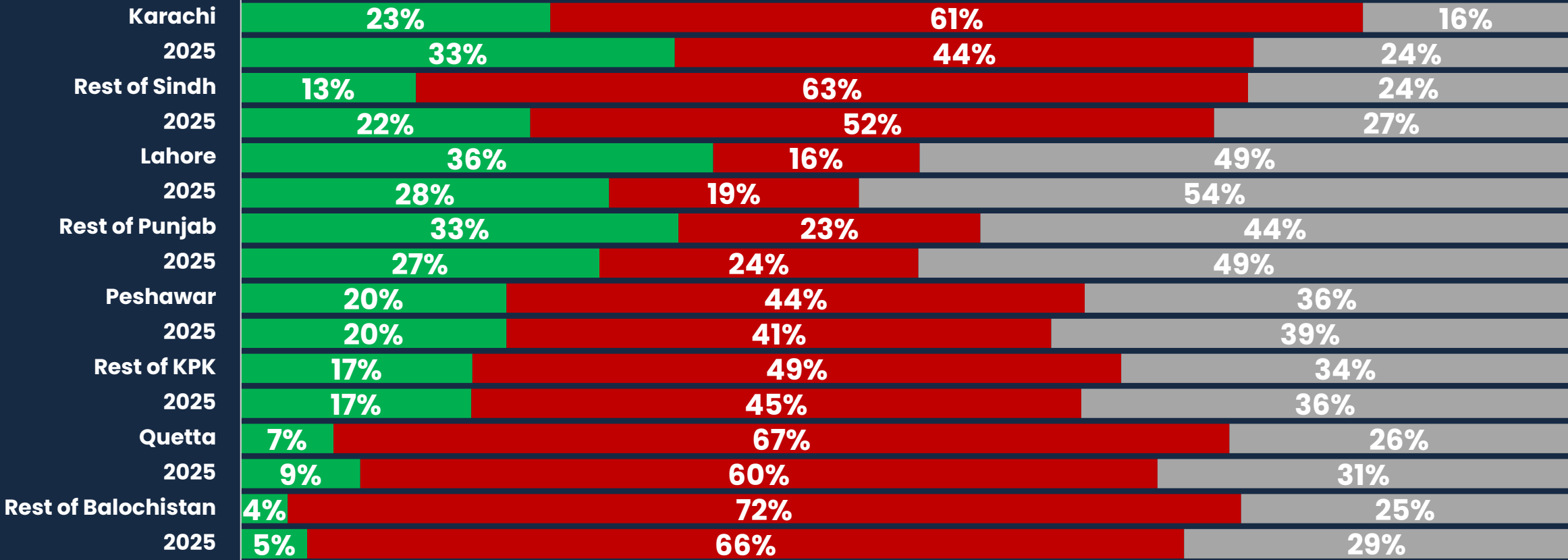


Business assessment largely stable, though operational security concerns have marginally increased.

TREND OF SERIOUS CRIMES

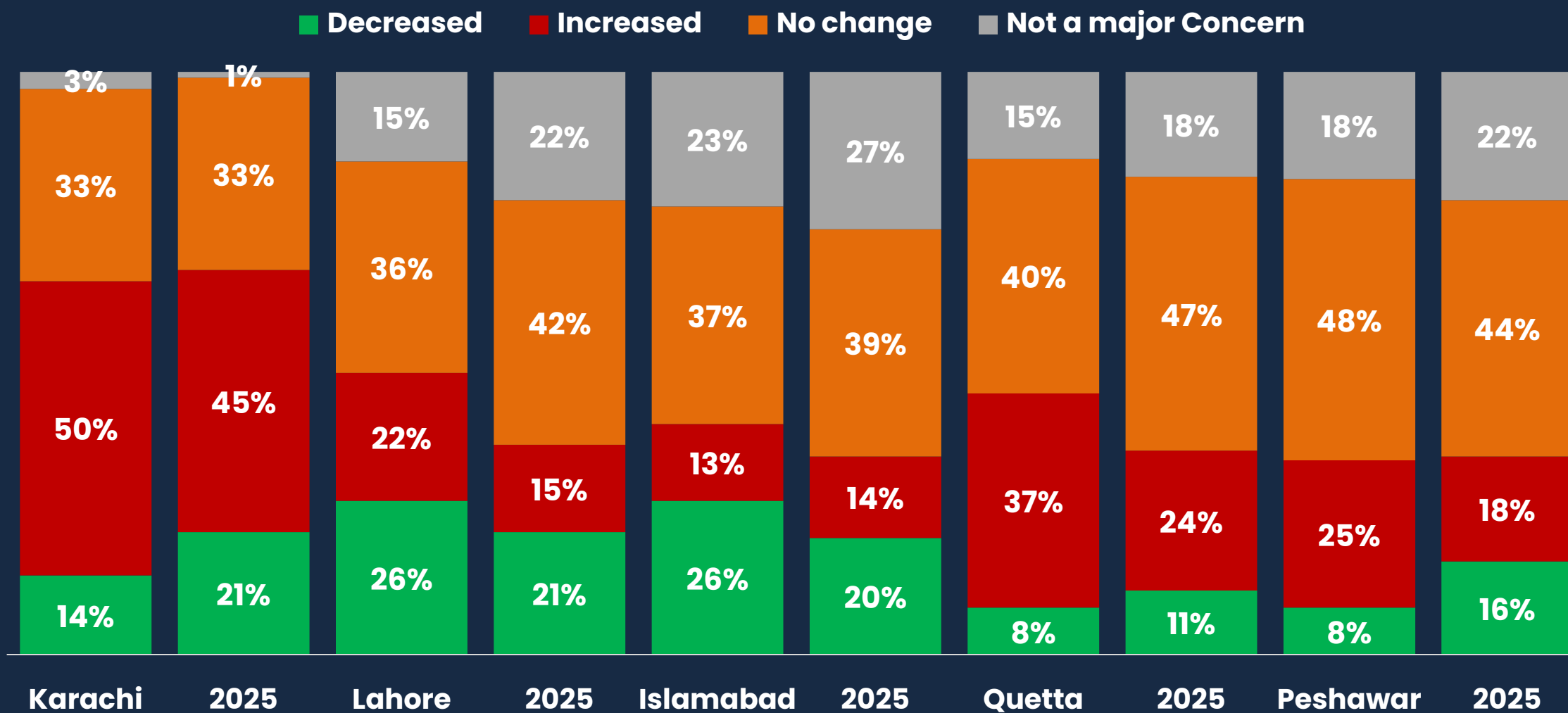

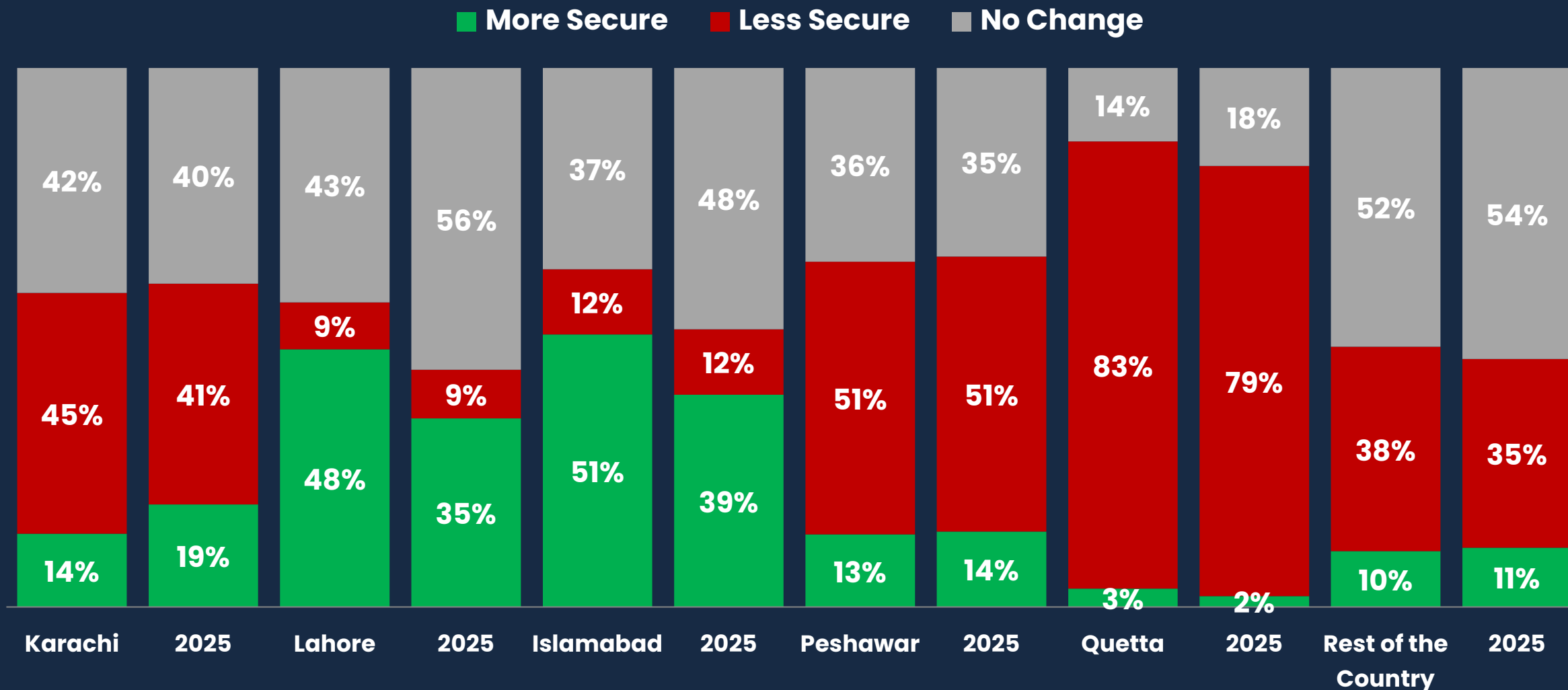
Serious crimes remains a concern.

TREND OF STREET CRIMES IN RELATION TO YOUR ORGANIZATION/ STAFF



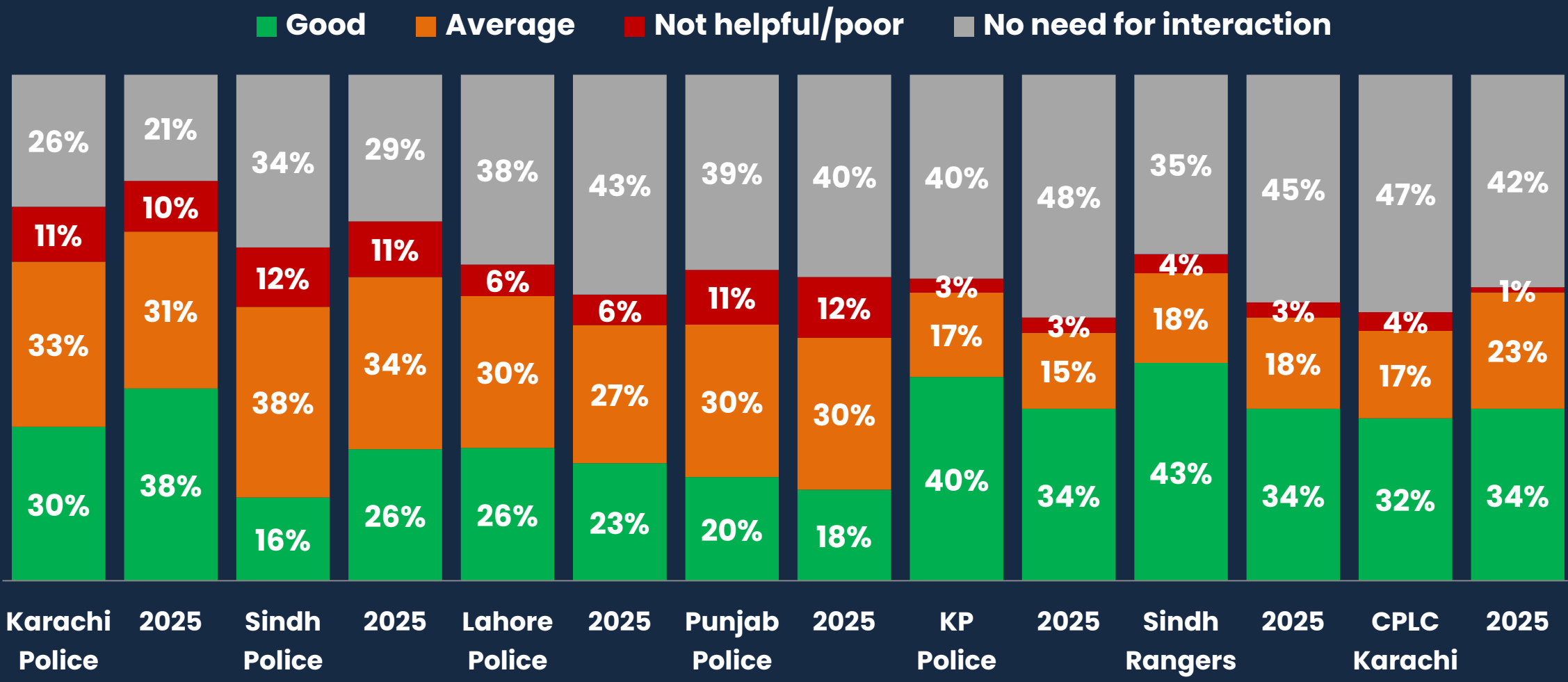
Street crime continues to be the primary security concern, especially in Karachi and Quetta.

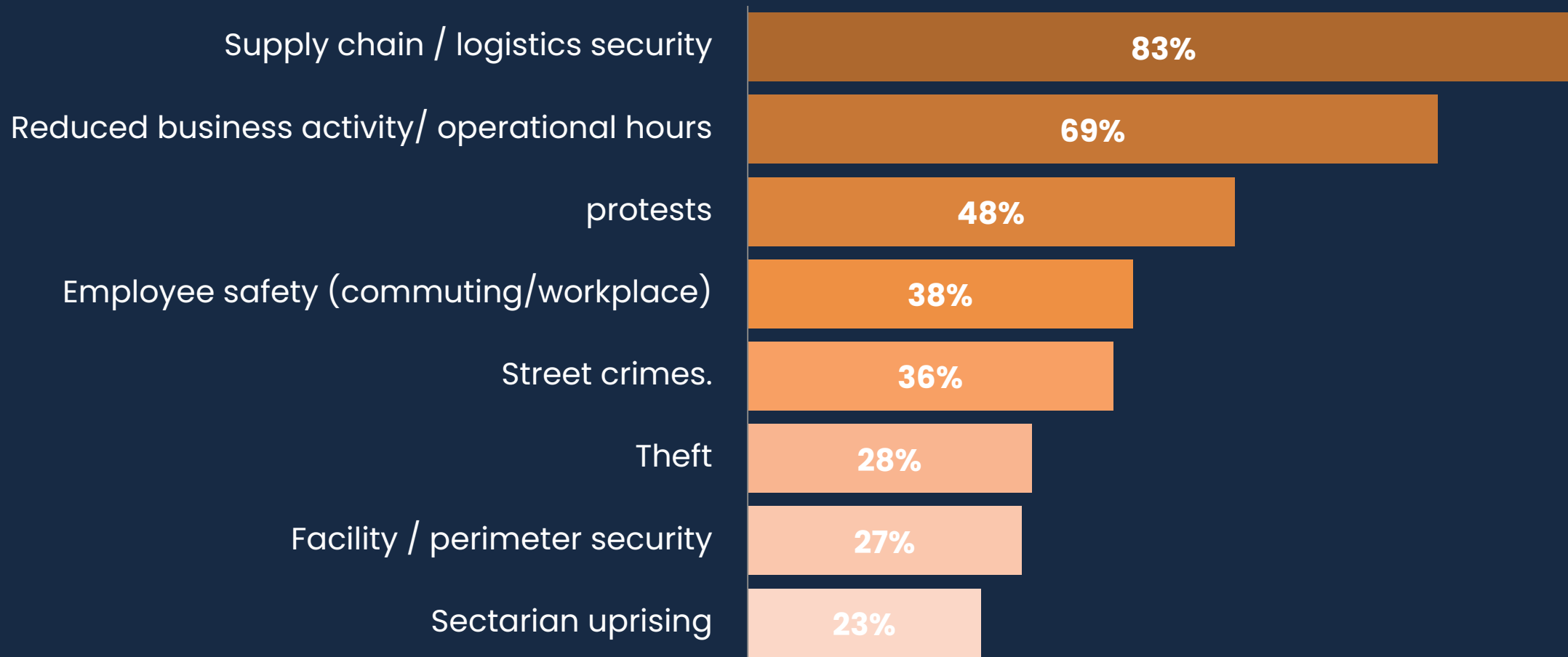
